Article XII. Health and Safety

Tobacco-Smoking Policy

Research has shown that smoking poses serious health risks not only to smokers but also to those exposed to secondhand smoke. Additionally, smoking contributes to increased absenteeism and decreased productivity in the workplace. In light of these concerns, **smoking is strictly prohibited anywhere on the Waikiki Community Preschool Complex premises**, which includes:

- **310 Paoakalani Avenue**
- **277 Ohua Avenue**

In accordance with Hawaii state law, **smoking is also prohibited within 20 feet of any entrance, exit, openable window, or ventilation intake** of any building.

This policy applies to all forms of smoking, including but not limited to:

- Cigarettes (including electronic cigarettes or e-cigarettes)
- Cigars
- Tobacco pipes
- Vapes and other Electronic Smoking Devices utilizing non-tobacco products

Waikiki Community Preschool is committed to providing a healthy and safe environment for all staff, children, families, and visitors. **We are a 100% smoke-free facility.**
