Mahalo for your interest in the high-quality early learning program at Waikiki Community Preschool. Applications are being accepted.

To be eligible, your child must be three- or four-years-old by July 31, 2026.

- For four-year-old children, they must be born between August 1, 2021, to July 31, 2022;
- For three-year-old children, they must be born between August 1, 2022, to July 31, 2023.

**Selection will be made by lottery. Families of children who submit complete applications will have the initial opportunity to be selected.**

- Families who submit this application form by **March 31, 2026**, will be considered first.
- Families who submit this application form by **April 30, 2026**, will be considered second.
- If any remaining slots exist, all other three- or four-year-old applicants will be considered for selection. Selection will be made on a first-come, first-served basis.

Children who are selected will have **five days** to submit the completed student enrollment forms to be considered enrolled. **If the forms are not received within five days, your child's name will be placed back on the waitlist.**

**The following forms must be completed and turned in to your charter school's office for your child to be considered for enrollment:**

1. The Student Enrollment form (SIS-10W);
2. Your child's birth certificate;
3. Income verification documents 2024 1040 Income Tax Returns (page one only), or proof of current TANF, SNAP eligibility, or verification of homelessness;
4. Attestation of Family Income form;
5. Proof of completion of all State Department of Health requirements on the completed Form 14, including:
  - a. A current tuberculosis screening;
  - b. A current physical exam with immunizations that are up-to-date based on the child's age, or if you are unable to complete this update of the physical exam in time, the scheduled appointment date when the health requirements shall be met; and
  - c. Completed Early Childhood Pre-K Health Record Supplement form (DHS 908).
